**ARE VOTING MACHINES BEING FAIRLY ALLOCATED?
WILL THERE BE ENOUGH PAPER BALLOTS?**

Shortages of machines and paper ballots can lead to long lines and voter disenfranchisement.

If you experienced shortages in the primary, call your local election office and ask how many machines will be in use in November.

Ask them how many paper ballots have been ordered to compensate for increased voter turnout.

Encourage your officials to base their allotment on the 2008 primary numbers.
