ANOTHER WAY TO GIVE A SHIFT - POLL MONITOR

Volunteer to monitor (watch) elections at polling sites. Arrange with a friend or neighbor to watch all the activities at your own polling place in 3 - 4 hour shifts. Or, be a "Rover" and visit a number of the "hot spot" neighborhoods where voter suppression is likely. Take a camera, get the facts. Observe, don't interfere.

Poll monitors keep written records on POLL MONITOR INCIDENT REPORTS. ONE INCIDENT = ONE REPORT. Briefly describe problems you witness, including issues of: voter registration, ballots, machines, poll workers, intimidation, access, language, etc.
